

Pool Tie-Breaking Procedures

Suggest do not leave the court area until you are sure there are no ties in the pool. You may have to play &/or ref.

2 teams tied for 1st Place: (Both advance to Gold)

- a) Head to Head match result
- b) Point spread in Head to Head matches
- c) Point differential for complete pool
- d) Coin flip

2 teams tied for 2nd Place: (One tied team advances to Gold)

One play-off set to 15, win by 2, NO CAP at the end of pool play, the losing team of the last match will officiate. If losing team must play then winning team of last match officiates.

2 teams tied for 3rd Place: (No tied teams advance to Gold)

Head to Head match result followed by b), c), and d) from above.

3 teams tied for 1st Place: (Two tied teams advance to Gold)

Seed by point differential for total pool (total points scored subtracted from total points scored against). 1st place will win by overall point differential. 2nd seed vs. 3rd seed will play a one set playoff to 15, win by 2, NO CAP, with the 1st place team officiating. This game will immediately follow pool play. Winner of the playoff is 2nd in pool, loser is 3rd in pool. If one of the teams involved leaves the area and can't be found to participate, they will get 3rd in pool. The other two teams will have their placement decided based on the tie-breaking procedure for 2 teams tied for 1st - both advance: which is the head to head match already played.

3 teams tied for 2nd Place: (One tied team advances to Gold)

Seed by point differential for total pool (total points scored subtracted from total points scored against). 1st seed officiates 2nd seed vs. 3rd seed in a one set playoff to 15, win by 2, NO CAP. 1st seed will then play the winner of that set to 15, win by 2, NO CAP with the loser of the first playoff game officiating. The winner of the second playoff game will be 2nd in the pool, the loser of the second playoff game will be 3rd in the pool and the loser of the first playoff game will be 4th in the pool. If one of the teams involved leaves the area and can't be found to participate, they will get 4th in the pool. The other two teams will have their placement decided based on the tie-breaking procedure for 2 teams tied for 2nd – one advances: which is playing a tie breaking set.
